Details	The TPP represents a challenge to East Asian economic integration while for India; the TPP represents a strategic opportunity at the economic, political and security level. Linking North America, South America and participating countries East Asia (including New Zealand and Australia), the TPP reorients trade relations across the Asia-Pacific instead of a China-centered economic integration model. By bolstering transpacific trade and in particular through the South China Sea, this paper argues that the TPP anchors TPP members economically and security-wise to the region. This buttressing of economic and security commitments to the region contributes to a multilateralization of the common goods associated with the South China Sea while increasing the stakes for countries interested in changing the status quo or engaging in assertive behaviour. This paper investigates the economic and security ramifications of the TPP and APEC from the perspective of India.

Details	China's emergence as the largest economy in East Asia has proceeded hand-in-hand with a more robust economic, political and security posture in the region. More assertive territorial positions, anti-Japanese demonstrations and tactical economic pressure exerted against Japan, the Philippines and Vietnam are recent examples of China's growing confidence in the region. Based on interviews with MOFA officials and Japanese business leaders in Japan, Hong Kong and China, this paper argues that Japan is proactively strategically hedging its economic trade and investment in China through reengagement with Southeast Asian countries at economic, political and security levels.

Details	The objective of this paper will be to examine Japan Southeast Asia security partnerships from an “East/Southeast Asian perspective”. In this process, the author will divide Southeast Asian countries into two categories, peripheral-core countries and core-peripheral countries. The author will argue that Japanese-Southeast Asian security partnerships cannot be understood with a blanket formula, rather we must divide ASEAN countries into “peripheral-core” and “core-peripheral” countries that have different security challenges and political-economic relationships vis-a-vis China. This bifurcation in two categories also encompasses the different competitive advantages each grouping has in terms of their position in the regional and global economic chain. It is the combination of these factors that drives and shapes East/Southeast perspectives of Japan Southeast Asia security partnerships.
